WHAT TO DO

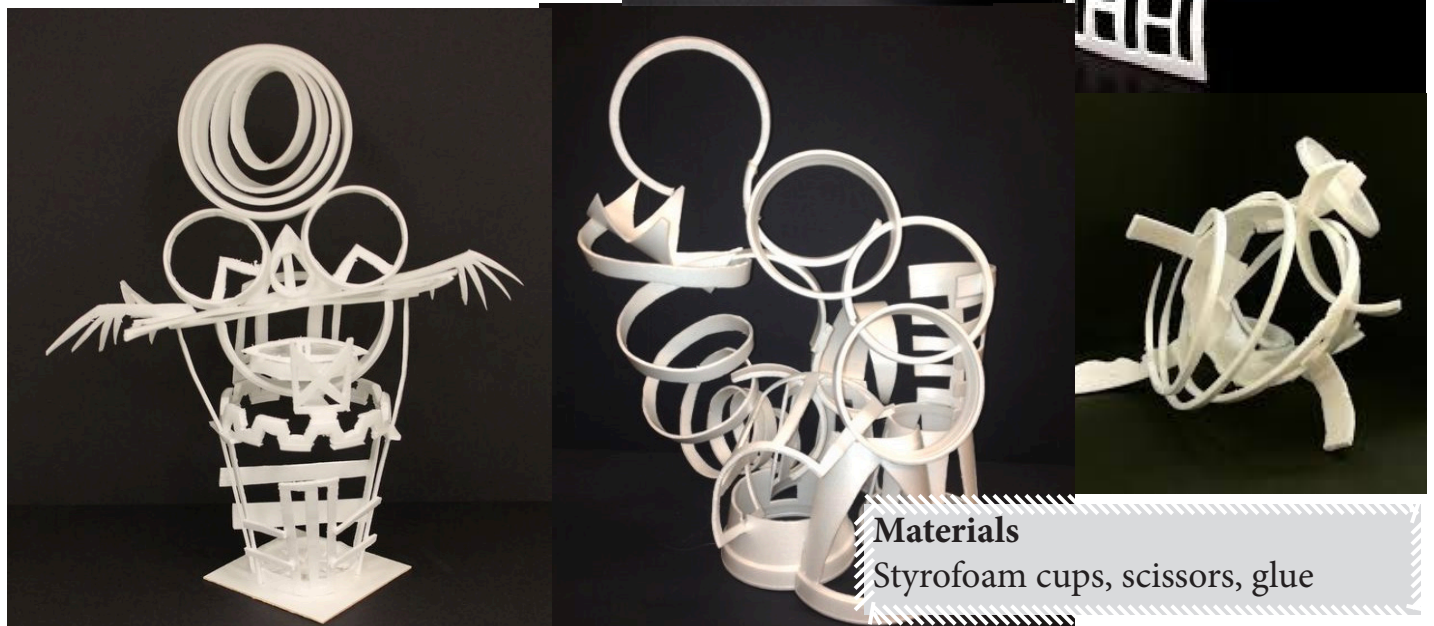
-Sometimes it's hard to jump from 2 dimensional art to 3 dimensional art. So, sometimes experimenting with materials is the best way to get acclimated!

-Begin by exploring this new material. Try out different ways to manipulate, cut, attach, and glue the pieces together.

-When building something new- don't only consider the pieces you're putting together- pay close attention to the empty space between. How does this spaced affect your piece overall?

-Consider how your piece looks from ALL angles. Turn your piece as you work on it.

-Make three of these using as many cups as you need. You will be graded on Effort, Craftsmanship, and 3 dimensionality of the final piece.
