Objective: You will create a sculptural card that is interactive and expresses gratitude.

WHAT TO DO

Consider something that you can't live without

Reflect on why you would be so strongly affected by its absence.

Brainstorm ideas about how to best illustrate gratitude to a specific person or experience. Then, design a sculptural card that is interactive and hides a message to the recipient. The card should use symbolism to illustrate the feeling of gratitude without having to articulate it directly with the words "thank you".

Examples:

- -A stethoscope with a heart shaped slit large enough to fit a small note intended for a nurse.
- -A framed collage for your favorite teacher with a hidden message under the frame stand.
- -A little oven with removable cookies for a grandparent. Each cookies has a little note.
