


# Zentangle Album Art

Name:

**Objective**: You will create a new album cover for a favorite musical artist or band using zentangle and design techniques used in class.

Frameworks Objective(2.16): Students will create artrwork that demonstrates a purposeful use of the elements and principles of design to convey meaning and emotion about music.



**Materials:** Bristol board, bic pen, water-color paint, brushes.

#### Overview:

Album Art: Art produced for the cover of records and CDs. Some artists specialized or gained fame through their work, notably the design team Hipgnosis (through their work on Pink Floyd albums in the 1970s). The talents of many photographers and illustrators have been used to produce a vast array of memorable LP/CD covers. Album covers serve the purpose of advertising the musical contents on the LP, through the use of graphic design, photography, and/or illustration. An album cover normally has the artist's name, sometimes in logo form; and the album title.

**Zentangle:** Is a fancy term for intense doodling. It's the art of using repetitive patterns in a series of made up shapes to create a more complex looking design. We will incorporate this method of doodling into our album designs.

**Ball Point Pen:** You most likely use this each and every day in your other classes! Little did you know that regular old ball point pens are perfect for achieving dynamic cross hatching.


## Use the following steps...

- -Practice zentangle in class and at home for homework while listening to music.
- -Come up with a design for your album cover (separate from your zentangle for now).
- -Combine your design, and one of your zentangles into one album cover design. (DEMO in class)
- -Outline your lines in bic pen, and use cross hatching techniques for texture. (DEMO in class)
- -Paint with watercolor paint. (DEMO in class)

### Assessment:

- -Effort: 20 points
- -Demonstrates the mood of the music chosen. *10 pts*
- -Facilitates a selective use of colors. 10 pts
- -Mastery of zentangle methods. 10 pts
- -Exploration of pen textures. 10 pts
- -Harmony between planned composition and zentangle design. *10 pts*

- -Used care with art materials: 20 pts







