
Objective: You will make tonal studies of a mundane space to depict light and mood.


Frameworks Objective (3.11): Demonstrate the ability to portray emotions and personality through the rendering of physical characteristics in 2D and 3D work

WHAT TO DO

- -In your sketchbook, do 5 gesture drawings of 5 mundane spaces around you (either in the classroom or at home). These are line drawings.
- -As shown to you in class- make 5 quick tonal studies of the same 5 spaces you just did gestures of. You can do these in your sketchbook as well.
- -In class choosing your favorite of the sketches for reference (as well as the space itself... you can either have a photo of it, or if it's in the classroom, you can work from observation). Make a large tonal drawing of this mundane space. Begin by toning the page. Then pull out large areas of light with your eraser. Slowly work around the entire composition and work from general to specific details.
